3 To **these** He also presented Himself alive ... appearing to **them** over a period of forty days, and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. 4 And gathering **them** together, He commanded **them** not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "**you** heard of from Me;
