Theme Woven Into Divine History Matt. 7:13-14

- Exod. 34:14 God is a jealous God.
- Deut. II:26 Pronounces a blessing or a curse upon man's chosen path
- Isa. 35:8 There is "a way" upon which the righteous will walk.

Jesus Reveals The Paths Available to Mankind Matt. 7:13-14

- The way to destruction that is occupied by the masses
- The way to life that is occupied by the few
- Most everyone believes they are among the latter, and none among the former.

"Gate" and "Way"

- That which is:
 - "Entered in"
 - "Walked upon"
- Requires:
 - I Thess. 2:12 Due attention
 - Eph. 4:1-3 Due response

Why are there few that find it?

Few Fail To Seek The Right Way

- Isa. 55:6-7 "Seek ye Jehovah while he may be found."
- Rom. 4:2-11 Only those who seek eternal life will receive it.
- Col. 3:1-4 "Seek the things that are above..."
- Heb. I I:6 "...them that seek after him."

Do you have questions regarding your spiritual condition?

Have you sought the answer, diligently?

The Way Is Strict

- Lk. 13:22-30 "for many...shall seek to enter in, and shall not be able"
- Vs. 24 Strive to enter in: "labouring fervently"

Because of Prejudice

- Prejudice:
 - "Preconceived judgment or opinion"
 - "An adverse opinion or leaning formed without just grounds or before sufficient knowledge"

Consequences of Prejudice

- Isa. 6:9-10 Condemned
- Matt. 13:14-15 Applied to the days of Jesus

Consequences of Prejudice

- Jn. 6:14-15 The people had formed an erroneous concept concerning the kingdom.
- Jer. 22:24, 30 No earthly king would sit on David's throne in Jerusalem.
- Lk. 17:20-12 Jesus attempted to teach the spiritual nature of the kingdom.
- Mk. 15:2 Jesus confessed that he was a King.
- In. 18:36 Yet, denied that His kingdom was of this world

Consequences of Prejudice

- Mk. 6: I-3 The people were caused to stumble as a result of prejudice.
- Isa. 8:14-15 So said the prophets
- Because Jesus did not conform to the opinions formed in the minds of the scribes and Pharisees, concerning the Messiah...they stumbled.

Prejudice did not die with the scribes and Pharisees

The Scriptures Say...

- Matt. 7:14 "narrow is the gate"
- Matt. 7:14 "straitened the way"
- Matt. 16:24 "let him deny himself"
- Eph. 4:5 "one faith"
- Eph. I:22-23; 4:4 "one body"

Man Says...

- All religious people will be saved.
- We are all going to the same place, but by different paths.
- Saved by faith only, apart from works
- Many faiths...chose one
- The church of your choice

Prov. 16:25
Let us recognize our dependence on God and put away our prejudice and seek His counsel in matters of godliness.

- Many warnings concerning false prophets:
 - 2 Cor. II:13-15 "Satan fashioneth himself into an angel of light."
 - 2 Pet. 2:1-2 "as among you also there shall be false teachers..."
 - Matt. 7:15-23 Jesus warns of the danger.

- False prophets/teachers
 - 2 Tim. 3:13 Deceive
 - 2 Pet. 2:19 Promise liberty while they themselves are bondservants of corruption

- Many are deceived:
 - Rom. 16:17-18 "by...smooth and fair speech"
 - Eph. 4:14 "by the sleight of men, in craftiness, after the wiles of error"
 - Col. 2:8 "through...philosophy and vain deceit"

- Many are deceived.
 - I Cor. 6:9 believing they can live as they wish and still enter the kingdom of heaven.
 - I Cor. 15:33 not believing that their companionships can corrupt them.
 - Gal. 6:7 in thinking they can mock God and not reap what they sow.
- 2 Tim. 3:13, 14-17 God's provisions to battle deception

Because of Peer Pressure

- Jn. 9:13-22 succumbing to the pressures of religious leaders.
- In. I2:42-43 succumbing to the pressures of companions
- Matt. 10:34-37 succumbing to the pressures of family
- I Pet. 4: I-6 succumbing to the pressures of friends

Because of Worldliness and Materialism

- Lk. 8:14 to be choked by the riches and pleasures of life
- Lk. 12:15-21 thinking that life is defined by possessions
- I Tim. 6:17-19 by putting one's confidence in the uncertainty of riches
- Matt. 6:24-34 by being anxious over day to day provisions
- I Tim. 6:10 by reaching after money

Because Disciples Fail The Work

- Rom. I:14-15 Paul considered himself in debt to preach the gospel.
- I Tim. I:12-16 Once a blasphemer, he obtained mercy.
- 2 Tim. 2:1-2 What he received he passed to others with the same admonition.
- I Thess. I:6-8 To imitate the Lord and the apostles in the proclaiming of the word
